



CHARDONNAY

TRUCHARD VINEYARD CARNEROS, NAPA VALLEY

Lying in the heart of Carneros, Truchard Vineyard is composed of volcanic ash and rock, and is prized for its rolling hills, sun exposure and cool, breezy conditions that allow long, even ripening. Nickel & Nickel farms five select acres of the 270-acre vineyard.

MEDINA VINEYARD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA

Planted in 1969, the 43-acre Medina Vineyard is located in the Green Valley subappellation of the Russian River Valley. Nickel & Nickel's 14-acre block consists of "Goldridge" sandy loam soils and rests on a gentle, rolling slope with a northeastern exposure. The cool coastal influences produce daytime temperatures that allow the grapes to slowly develop full ripeness.

STILING VINEYARD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA

Located in the Green Valley subappellation of the Russian River Valley, this vineyard was established by the Stiling family in 1988. Planted in Goldridge sandy loam soils, the site produces vines of moderate vigor. We source our fruit from 10.5 acres within the 35-acre vineyard.

MERLOT

HARRIS VINEYARD OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

The 50-acre Harris Vineyard is located in Oakville, just east of Branding Iron Vineyard. Nickel & Nickel's five acres are comprised of two blocks that offer a southern exposure and soil that consists of gravelly clay loam.

SUSCOL RANCH NAPA VALLEY

The nine-acre Suscol Ranch vineyard is located in Jamieson Canyon, south of the city of Napa. Planted on a north-facing knoll in deep, loamy soil, the vines are cordon trained to give the grapes maximum sun exposure. The area is very cool, with dense fog early in the season and windy conditions all year long.

SYRAH

DARIEN VINEYARD RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY, SONOMA

Tucked into the gently rolling hills of the Russian River Valley, Darien Vineyard has a moderate climate with well-drained, loamy soils. Cool morning fog keeps the temperatures from getting too hot and allows the exposed fruit to ripen evenly. Nickel & Nickel's three-and-three-quarter acres are comprised of two clones that contribute different flavors to the wine.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON

HAYNE VINEYARD ST. HELENA, NAPA VALLEY

The Hayne Vineyard is situated in St. Helena at the base of the Mayacamas Mountains, where warm temperatures are ideal for producing beautiful, jammy fruit. The vines are moderate in size due to the gravelly, loam soils. Nickel & Nickel produces wine from nine acres of this low-yielding vineyard.

C.C. RANCH RUTHERFORD, NAPA VALLEY

C.C. Ranch sits along the slope of a knoll west of the Silverado Trail. The vineyard is planted on well-drained, gravelly loam soil and the climate is ideal for the variety due to the warm summer temperatures that mature tannins and ripen fruit. Nickel & Nickel produces wine from 15 select acres of this vineyard.

QUARRY VINEYARD RUTHERFORD, NAPA VALLEY

Located on the slopes above the Silverado Trail on the east side of Rutherford, Nickel & Nickel sources Quarry Vineyard Cabernet from three distinct hillside blocks. The rocky loam soils are well drained and grow vines of moderate vigor.

TENCH VINEYARD OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

Situated on the eastern edge of Oakville along the Silverado Trail, Tench Vineyard features red, rocky soil containing clay and volcanic rock. Nickel & Nickel produces Cabernet from just nine acres of the vineyard.

BRANDING IRON VINEYARD OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

The eight-and-a-half-acre Branding Iron Vineyard lies in the western part of Oakville close to the base of the Mayacamas Mountains. The vineyard is comprised of well-drained clay loam, and the vines are vertically trellised to maximize sunlight and open the canopy.

KELHAM VINEYARD OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

The 52-acre Kelham Vineyard is located at the base of the western hills of Oakville. The soil is comprised of well-drained, clay loam, which produces vines and clusters of moderate size. Nickel & Nickel produces Cabernet from just seven acres of the vineyard.

ROCK CAIRN VINEYARD OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

Rock Cairn lies near the southern edge of the Oakville appellation, east of Highway 29 and north of the town of Yountville. The dry-farmed site is comprised of deep, gravelly loam with a western exposure. Nickel & Nickel selects grapes from nine acres of the vineyard.

JOHN C. SULLENGER VINEYARD® OAKVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

The home vineyard of Nickel & Nickel, Sullenger Vineyard is situated in the heart of Oakville. Its 30 acres of clay loam soil are planted exclusively to Cabernet Sauvignon.

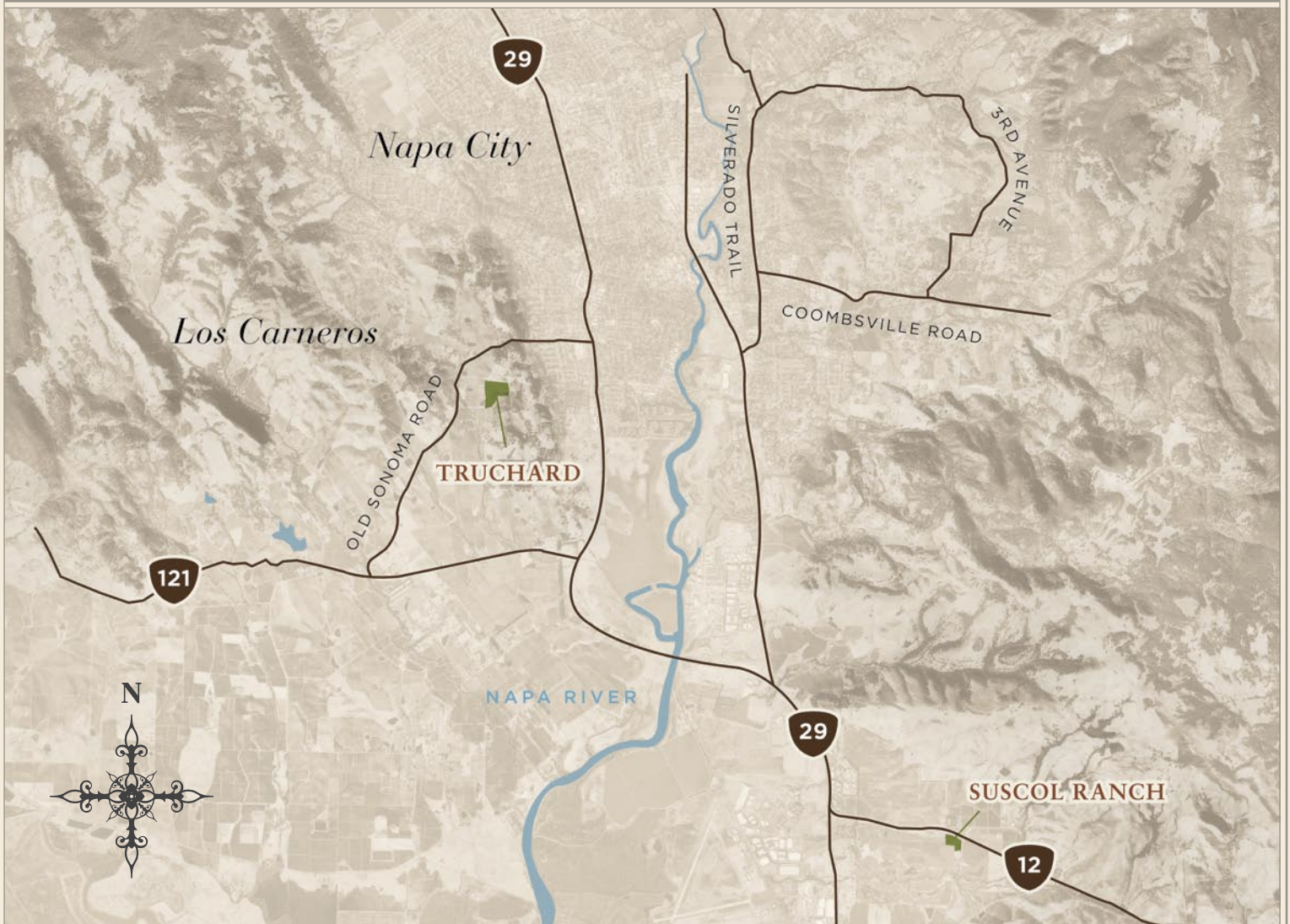
STATE RANCH YOUNTVILLE, NAPA VALLEY

The 23-acre State Ranch is located northeast of the town of Yountville. The rocky, loam soil has excellent drainage and grows Cabernet Sauvignon vines and clusters that are moderate in size. Nickel & Nickel produces wine from 11 acres of the vineyard.
